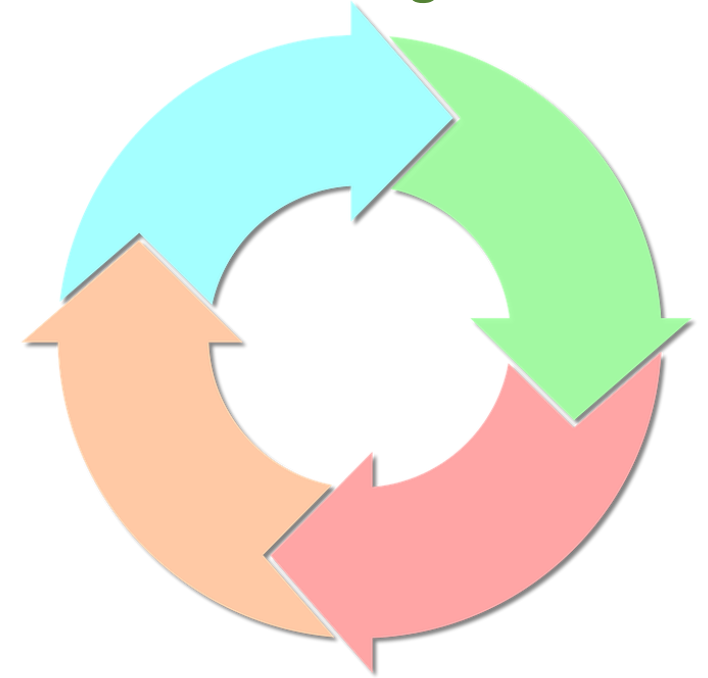
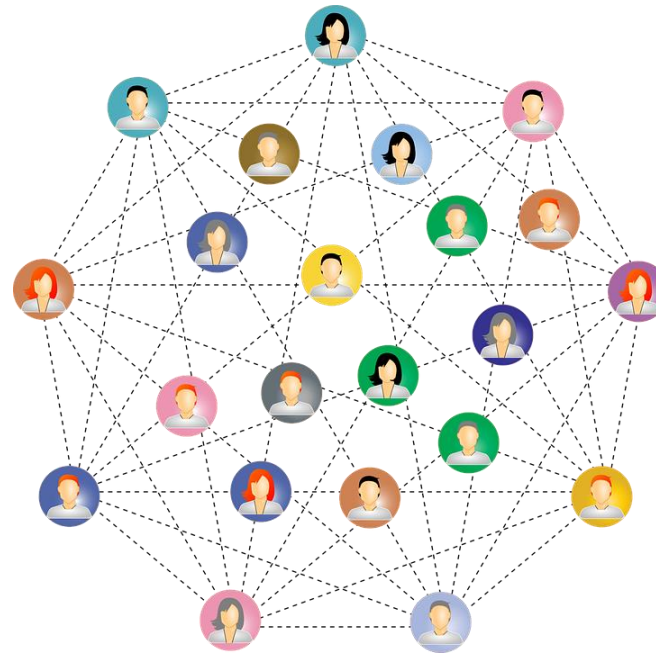


DESIGN THINKING OF SOLUTIONS FOR INTEGRATION OF REFUGEES



What is design thinking?

Design Thinking is an **iterative process** in which we seek to understand the user, challenge assumptions, and redefine problems in an attempt to identify alternative strategies and solutions that might not be instantly apparent with our initial level of understanding.

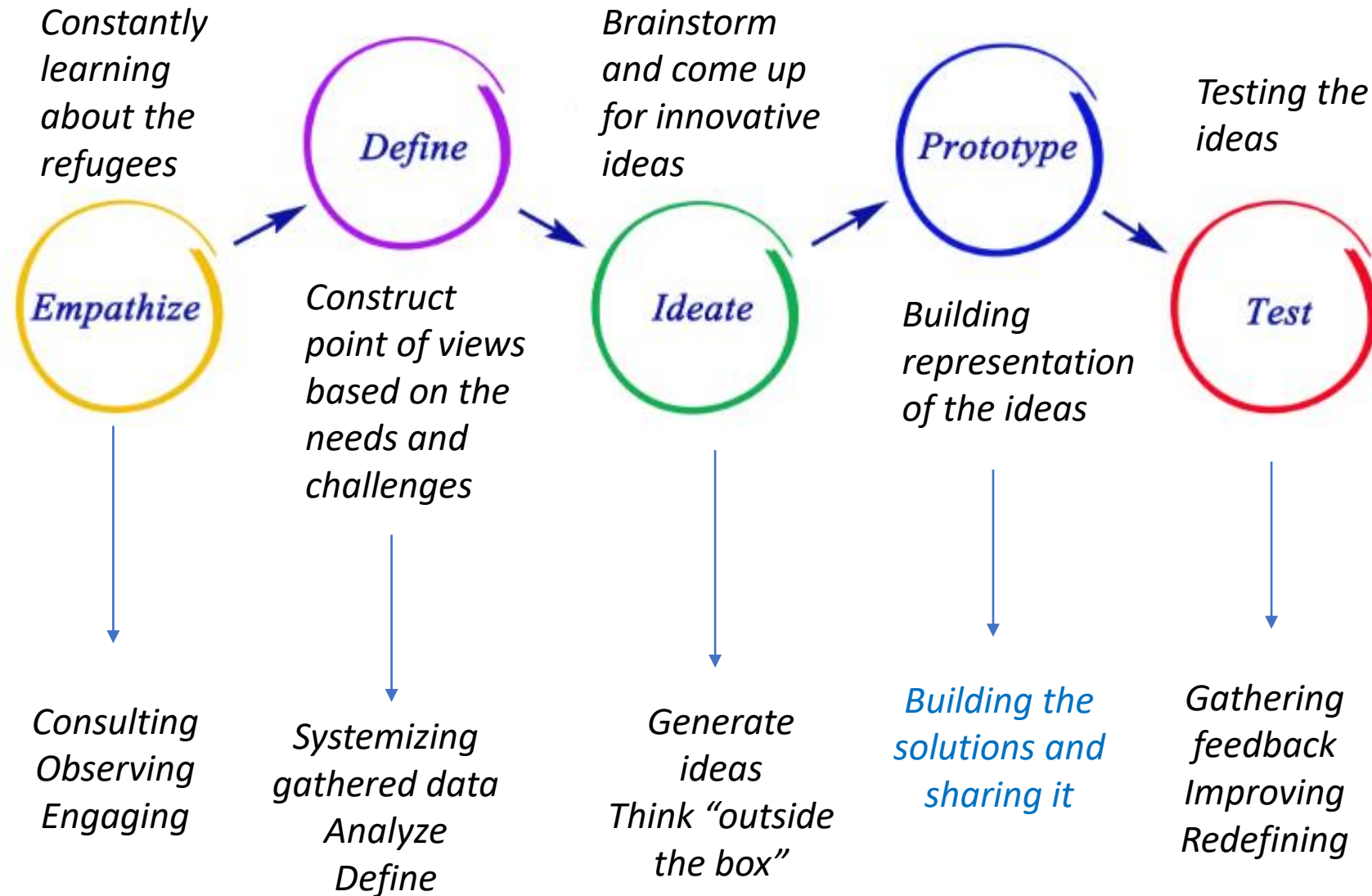


Design Thinking provides a solution-based approach to solving problems. It is a way of thinking and working as well as a collection of hands-on methods.

Why design thinking for solutions on refugee integration?

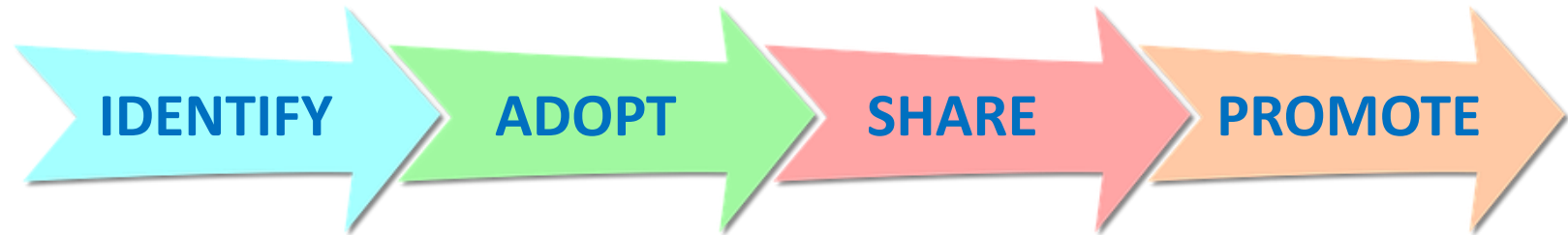
- ✓ Revolves around a **deep interest** in developing an understanding of the refugees for whom we're designing the solutions
- ✓ Observe and develop **empathy** with the target user.
- ✓ **Process of questioning:** questioning the problem, questioning the assumptions, and questioning the implications
- ✓ **Tackling problems** that are ill-defined or unknown, by re-framing the problem in *human-centric ways*
- ✓ **Creating ideas** in brainstorming sessions, and adopting a hands-on approach in *prototyping* and *testing*
